SECTION 6: Accidental release measures

6.1. Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

For non emergency personnel: restrict access of outsiders to the affected area until appropriate decontamination operations have been finished. For large releases insulate the threatened area. Do not inhale vapours and aerosols. Avoid skin and eye contact. Remove all ignition sources, extinguish open fire, do not smoke. Use personal protective equipment. 8.2. Exposure controls

12.4. Mobility in soil

Product spreads in the soil; It can penetrate deep into the soil and cause pollution groundwater.
