SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

Take care of your own safety. If any health problems are manifested or if in doubt, inform a doctor and show him information from this safety data sheet. If unconscious, put the person in the stabilized (recovery) position on his side with his head slightly bent backwards and make sure that airways are free; never induce vomiting. If the person vomits by himself, make sure that the vomit is not inhaled. In life threatening conditions first of all provide resuscitation of the affected person and ensure medical assistance. Respiratory arrest - provide artificial respiration immediately. Cardiac arrest - provide indirect cardiac massage immediately.

If inhaled

Remove the victim to fresh air, keep warm and at rest. The conscious person should be placed in a semi-sitting position, the unconscious person should be placed in the recovery position. Control and maintain airway patency. In case of breathing disorders, give oxygen; use artificial respiration in case of lack of breath. Get medical attention immediately.

If on skin

Take off contaminated clothing. Wash contaminated skin with plenty of soap and water, and then rinse with water. In case of disturbing symptoms, consult a doctor. Wash clothes before reuse.

If in eyes

Protect non-irritated eye, remove contact lenses. Rinse contaminated eyes thoroughly with water for at least 10 minutes. with open eyelids. Avoid strong water stream - risk of cornea damage. Consult a doctor if disturbing symptoms occur.

If swallowed

DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING! Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If the injured is conscious, rinse mouth thoroughly with water. In case of spontaneous vomiting, tilt the injured person forward in order to avoid choking. Consult a doctor immediately, show the packaging or label.

4.2. Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

If inhaled

Possible irritation of airways, cough, headache. May cause drowsiness or dizziness.

If on skin

For a prolonged contact possible dryness, skin cracking and chronic dermatitis.

If in eyes

Redness, tearing, burning.

If swallowed

Abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, there is a risk of aspiration of the product into the lungs, which may lead to aspiration pneumonia and, in extreme cases, death.

4.3. Indication of any immediate medical attention and special treatment needed

5.2. Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture

In the event of fire, carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide and other toxic gases may arise. Inhalation of hazardous degradation (pyrolysis) products may cause serious health damage. Vapors with air may form explosive mixtures.

5.3. Advice for firefighters

Do not stay in a fire hazardous area without appropriate chemical-resistant clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. Cool tanks at risk of fire with a water spray from a safe distance. Collect used extinguishing media. Do not allow them to enter surface water, ground water and soil.

SECTION 6: Accidental release measures

6.1. Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

For persons not belonging to the personnel eliminating the consequences of the accident: limit the access of bystanders to the accident area until the completion of appropriate cleaning operations. In case of large spills, isolate the endangered area. Do not inhale vapors and aerosols. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Keep away all sources of ignition, extinguish open fire, do not smoke.
